Scope and content note:

This series was created by Gerald W. Siegel while he served as executive assistant to the chairman of the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). The series accompanied Siegel when he became an aide to then Senate Majority Leader Lyndon B. Johnson and were donated to Lyndon B. Johnson's presidential library with Johnson's senate papers.

The series includes correspondence, memoranda, notes, legal briefs, and publications covering Siegel's work at the SEC. Specific topics include securities fraud, copyright, postal regulations, extradition, negotiations, administrative practices, and individual legal cases.

Note: This papers in this collection were incorrectly described as a series in the Senate Papers of Lyndon B. Johnson before being relocated and renamed in 2025.
