Scope and content note:

This series contains correspondence that was turned over to staff of the White House Central Files (WHCF) too late to be filed in the proper place before being archived. A preponderance of the correspondence was created late in Johnson's presidency, and staff simply did not have time to classify and file the material before the administration ended.

Some of the correspondence, however, had been classified and filed in the WHCF but was removed at some point during the administration by White House staff, who then returned the items too late for Central File staff to refile them. Accordingly, while most of this series dates from late in the administration, these materials may come from any time during the administration.

The correspondence may be from any series of the White House Central Files and be related to any topic. They may or may not include WHCF classification information.
